Wi-Tron, Inc. Issues Supplemental Information to October 3, 2006 Press Release

RARITAN, N.J., October 6, 2006 -- Wi-Tron, Inc. (OTCBB: [WTRQ](#), [News](#)), a developer and manufacturer of high-tech ultra-linear power amplifiers, today provided additional information to clarify its intent to conduct a private placement to raise \$3-5 million.

Neither Wi-Tron's press release of October 3, 2006 nor this press release constitute an offer to sell or the solicitation of an offer to buy securities and shall not constitute an offer, solicitation or sale in any jurisdiction in which such offer, solicitation or sale is unlawful. The Units and the securities comprising the Units, including the common stock, warrants, and shares of common stock underlying the warrants have not been registered under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended, or applicable state securities laws and, unless so registered, may not be offered or sold in the United States except pursuant to an exemption from the registration requirements of the Securities Act and applicable state securities laws.

Wi-Tron's investor relations representative, Craig H. Bird, President of Segue Ventures noted, "Wi-Tron is committed to fair disclosure and complying with Regulation FD. Management decided the capital raise constituted a material event and disclosed this to the public, however there was no intent to solicit or advertise." The private placement is offered only to eligible investors. Wi-Tron will be presenting at the Southern California Investment Association's (SCIA - www.sciaonline.org) Micro Cap Conference this Saturday morning in Irvine, CA and at the Arch Investment Conference on October 17th (<http://www.archconferences.com/>).

Wi-Tron intends to use the net proceeds of this offering to complete its reorganization, increase its R&D program and for working capital and general corporate purposes. The offering is expected to close on November 15th 2006, subject to customary closing conditions.
